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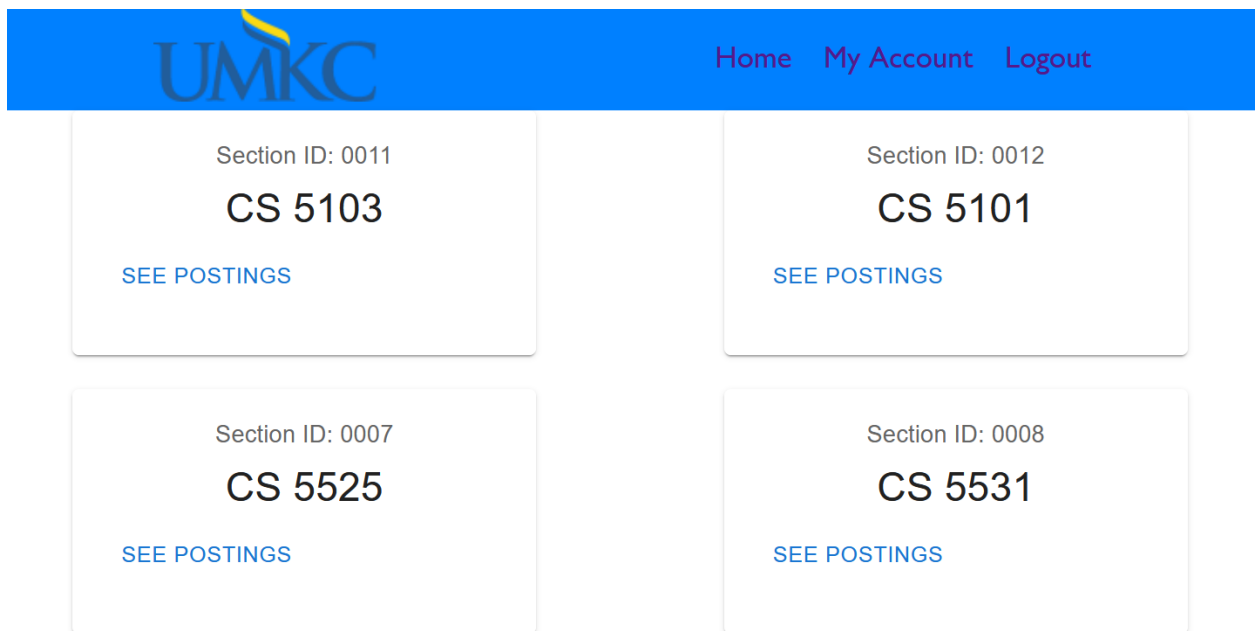

1. Introduction

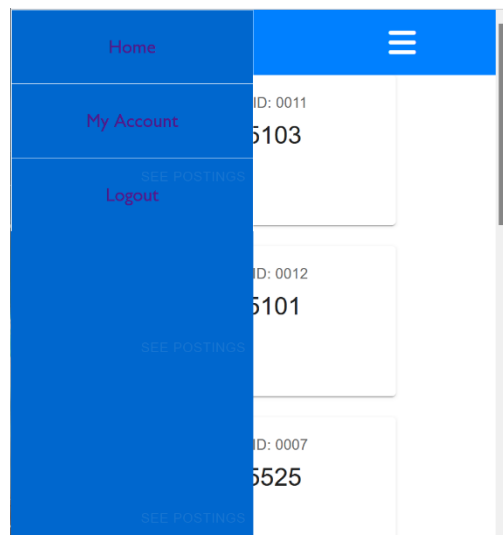
This user guide provides instructions on how to use the GTA Application Submission portal. Users of this application will have an account set up in the system prior to use, although guests may open positions without logging in. This guide will provide instructions on viewing open positions, logging in, and submitting applications.

2. Getting Started

When first accessing the application, you will land on the home page. The navbar at the top of the screen allows for quick access to additional pages.



NOTE: On mobile devices, the navbar can be accessed through the hamburger menu icon in the top right corner of the screen.



3. Viewing Open Positions

Cards are displayed in the main body of the page. Each card corresponds to a class that has open positions. To view more details about a specific position, click SEE POSTINGS. The next screen shows class information as well as any open positions. Users will be prompted to login before submitting an application.

4. Logging In
